[Economic Profile System](#) (EPS) and [Populations at Risk](#) (PAR) are free, quick, and easy-to-use web-based tools that create reports about your geography of interest.

The tools are used by researchers, university instructors, economic development consultants, grant writers, local and state elected officials, city managers, land use planners, federal land management agencies, reporters, and others.

EPS and PAR use federal data sources—such as the Bureau of Economic Analysis, Bureau of Labor Statics, Bureau of the Census, and others—to produce reports on a wide variety of topics such as local economic, demographic, and land use trends.
